Brother Jesús Sanchez, who was dying with kidney failure a few months ago, has returned to pastor his 2 churches in Nayarit. He is on dialysis 2 days a week so continue to pray for him. There has been a forward move in the village of Camichin, where several have been baptized this fall. There has been a lot of preparation and sowing the Seed of the Word of God, who is faithful in time of harvest.
