*Praise the Lord - we are now getting established in our new home. On June 9, the moving van arrived on time at our home in Guadalajara. They had our belongings well protected and packed in the van in 2 hours and left with us following for Tepic. 15 minutes into the journey the van halted and we sat for 2 more hours while literal shade tree mechanics worked until the motor sprung to life again. 3 hours later we were at our destination – nothing lost or broken.*

*It has truly been an Abramic move. Jesus spoke to us to move and directed us to build our smaller home near the Bible School. We obeyed and left the modern city of Ur (Guadalajara) for Canaan, a land flowing with sugar cane and banana trees. We are in a different world, a different culture. Not only are we almost 3000 feet lower in altitude than Guadalajara, but we are also in an area much more tropical and closer to the Pacific Ocean.*

*We still have ecologically correct garbage arrangements. Cans are sold for the benefit of the school, all edible waste gets carried (by us) to the duck pen while the rest is taken in a wheel barrow (by us) to the pit where it is burned. We have one advantage over our other homes – we have 2 automatic lawn mowers that fertilize as they cut. One is brown and the other is black and white – the make is commonly known as calves.*

*Truly we are blessed abundantly. For the first time in 29 years we can see family members daily. From our vantage point on the side of a large extinct volcano we look over the green cane fields to the mountains that separate us from the ocean. There is little traffic and the air is clean and fresh. There are numerous new opportunities for ministry and already we are entering into some of these. There are constant challenges in counseling and as the new school year begins the end of August we shall again be teaching in both the Bible School and the Christian Secondary School. This morning we were privileged to see the graduation of our grandson, Simri, from this school, only the second time we have been able to see one of our 14 grandchildren graduate.*

*Last weekend we traveled to San Pedro, Coahuila, to participate in the coming of age church service of Stephen's daughter, Elisa. It was a blessed time and also a privilege to see more than 15 people, including 2 young couples, be baptized in Jesus' name.*

*We are anxiously anticipating the rainy season which is late this year. There is much promise of rain at times in the clouds but we know the promised rains will come. In the same way we desire to be messengers bringing the rivers of living water to people who have never heard the Gospel or known Jesus. We must go forward and slack not.*

*We are your hands extended here in the State of Nayarit. We thank you for your faithfulness to us and to Seedtime & Harvest Ministries. God has promised that while the earth remains seedtime and harvest will continue. We claim His promise naturally and spiritually with your prayers and generous offering on our behalf.*
